CES staff are currently working with an FDA-registered 503B outsourcing facility manufacturing veterinary medications (injections, ophthalmics, oral liquids, tablets), to augment industrial hygiene and health & safety protocols to ensure the continued well-being of their employees. Projects currently underway including job hazard analyses and PPE hazard assessments, as well as the development of site-specific chemical hygiene and performance-based pharmaceutical banding exposure control programs.
